## Who We Are:

Oceanside Building Learning Together's (OBLT) goal is to enhance lifelong learning with **FREE** early learning and literacy programs for babies through seniors. Since our inception in 1999, the needs of the community have evolved, and we've adapted to meet those changing needs.

## What is Saturday Breakfast Club?

Saturday Breakfast Club (SBC) is a unique program held at Munchkinland Parksville on select Saturdays. This free program brings together the joy of food, play, stories, and song while exploring food literacy and enhancing food security. In addition to breakfast being served, take-home packages will be offered with ingredients and recipes to create at home. There will be space for up to ten children (subject to change) and their caregivers to attend each session.

## What does this volunteer opportunity look like?

- Be available two or more Saturdays per month (September – June)
- Assist primarily with set-up, clean-up, and food prep.
- Support program facilitator as needed throughout the duration of the morning session.

## Skills & Requirements:

- Follow directions from Program Facilitator
- Work independently or alongside another volunteer
- Enjoy being around children
- RCMP Criminal Record Check (free for volunteers, OBLT will provide a letter)
